Motion & Discussion on Accepting Minutes from 07-06-2021.

Public Hearings

- Motion by PB Cauldwell to Open Public Hearing. 2nd by PB LaRue. Motion Carried, Vote was 4-0. PASS
- Alan Caron, 11 Knotty Pine Drive, to extend existing dock into Torsey Lake to a depth of 5 foot. Alan provided the depth measurements per 10 foot linear distance from the end of the existing dock into Torsey Lake. They were as follows:
 - Depth was 23" at the end of the existing dock
 - Depth was 18" at 10'
 - o Depth was 26" at 20'
 - Depth was 48" at 30'
 - Depth was 50" at 40"
 - Depth was 54" at 50'
 - o Depth was 60" at 60'

Even with this extension, the dock does not reach beyond the weeds growing in the lake.

- Shawn and Jack Painter, abutters voiced their concerns regarding the distance the Caron's dock would extend into the lake. Shawn and Jack pointed out that there was never vegetation growing in the lake until the summer camp closed its doors.
- Motion by PB Cauldwell to Close Public Hearing at 8:30 PM. 2nd by PB LaRue. Motion Carried, Vote was 4-0. PASS
- Motion by PB Dwelley to Approve Alan Caron's dock extension to a depth of 5 foot. 2nd by PB LaRue. Motion Carried, Vote was 4-0. PASS
- It was noted by Bill Butler, Code Enforcement, that in the future it would be a good idea to make a finding referencing Land Use Ordinance Page 61, Section 3: Piers, Docks, Wharfs, Bridges and Other Structures and Uses Extending Over or Beyond the Normal High-Water Line of a Water Body or Within a Wetland and Shoreland Stabilization.

 noise specs, but for now this is only a building permit.

 children. There may be an egress issue if the total number of trips exceeds ten (10) per
 day. At that point it will need to go before the Planning Board but currently the only
 requirement is a CEO permit. The business is licensed by the state.
